### **F5/6/06 £500 GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE TOWN CARNIVAL**

Members reviewed this grant application, whilst noting that £250 had been given to the town carnival every year until last year (2005), when £500 was requested and granted. In light of the Council's current financial situation, members had previously resolved that grant applications, other than those requested for specific dates, would be deferred for consideration at the September meeting of the Finance and General Purposes Committee, unless for a specific event taking place before September. This application was therefore considered at the June 5<sup>th</sup> meeting.

Members requested that this application be granted in the sum of £500 from the Hannah Kennington charity.

The charity trustees, Cllrs H Potts and Mrs E Langan held a separate meeting and agreed to the donation being so given.

**RESOLVED** that this be recommended to Council.

Cllr Budding, as RFO, reported his intention to open the new charity accounts at the Cumberland Building Society in the near future, since no suitable account could be opened at the Post Office as previously intended.
